- 2. Authors of accepted abstracts will be invited to submit and present their work at the Seminar. The Authors of accepted abstracts will be informed in due time over email.
- 3. After the Seminar, only selected Papers will be published in an Edited Volume based on the recommendations of the Expert Committee. We will inform through email the selected authors to submit their full length papers after the completion of the Seminar.
- 4. The abstract and the final submission must be typed in Times New Roman, with font size 12 point normal and 1.5 line spacing.
